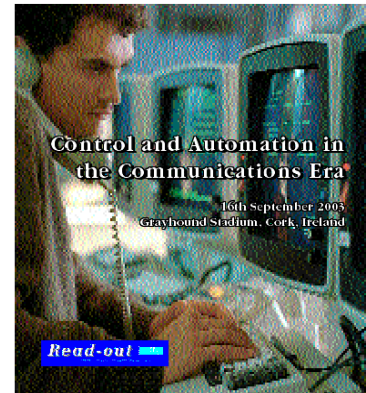
The conference will allow the attendees to examine all 4 aspects of control in the modern era particularly in the light of the communications revolution of the last ten years.
