- Final presentations, incorporating the Committee's feedback, shall be submitted by Monday 4th November.
- Presentation slides should be developed using the provided conference template.
- The content of the presentations should be aligned with the conference objectives and themes.
- Presenters are expected to adhere to a presentation duration of 15-20 minutes.
- The slides should not contain promotional content for products, organizations, or individuals.
- Authors should provide a brief biography and a photograph along with their abstract.
